## Leadership & Support Staff Summer Camp @ DaySpring

- Assistant Director Ideally 22+. Provides oversight and direction to the daily operations of summer camps at DaySpring. Assists the Director of Camp and Outdoors in all administrative, leadership, and supervisory tasks associated with running camp. Should have ample knowledge of supervising others and providing care to children of all ages as they experience time away from home.
- Leadership Director–20+. Provides supervision to male and female counselors and junior counselors. Develops a robust staff training program and builds an atmosphere of mutual accountability in order to cultivate compassionate and strong summer camp leaders. Maintains healthy boundaries and open communication channels with all staff members ensuring a spirit of belonging and a cooperative atmosphere of trust. As a member of the support staff, also leads programs as delegated.
- Waterfront Director– 21+. Provides supervision to all pool and waterfront programs. Trains lifeguards in all camp waterfront safety expectations and procedures. Maintains equipment and monitors that lifeguarding staff is practicing safety and maintaining waterfront expectations. As a member of the support staff, also leads programs as delegated. Must have current lifeguard certificate and at least one prior position as a lifeguard.
- Activities Director– 20+. Provides supervision to all program areas (except waterfront) and is the senior advisor to evening programs. Maintains equipment and coordinates with staff to practice safety at all times, keep camp wellresourced and encourage staff creativity. Communicates all supply needs and keeps all program areas well-maintained. As a member of the support staff, also leads programs as delegated.
- Nurse– 22+. Provides daily medical supervision to all members of the camp community including staff and campers. Administers medications according to best practices and provides basic healthcare to the level of their ability, training, and in cooperation with our standing orders. Must have current RN license OR a license from a State that has reciprocity agreement with State of Florida.
